Dear Daniel Brown:

Enclosed is a permit modification to Solid Waste Permit No. 101389 for the operation of the Frey Farm Landfill, issued in accordance with Article V of the Solid Waste Management Act, 35 P.S. Sections 6018.101, et seq.

This modification approves various design changes to the Vertical Expansion of the Frey Farm Landfill, including minor changes in the construction sequence of the Vertical Expansion, an additional MSE berm access ramp, and minor changes to the Cell 4 sump design that will eliminate the need for an additional pump station. This modification also approves the use of polyester geogrids and geosynthetic chimney drains in the MSE berm, as well as updated weather station equipment, specifically wind monitoring equipment.

Compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in the permit is mandatory. You have the right to file an appeal as to these terms and conditions.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal the action to the Environmental Hearing Board (Board) pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. § 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa.C.S.A. Chapter 5A. The Board's address is:

Nothing herein shall be construed to supersede, amend or authorize violation of the provisions of any valid and applicable local law ordinance, or regulation, provided that said local law, ordinance or regulation is not preempted by the Pennsylvania Solid Waste Management Act, the Act of July 7, 1980, Act 97, 35 P.S. § 6018.101, et seq.
